Young People's Services

Jigsaw Education Programme

- Presents workshops in schools, youth groups, hostels etc for children aged from 7 years old up to early twenties throughout Norfolk.
- Topics explored include: grooming on and offline, internet safety, sexting and healthy relationships.
- General preventative work in classes and large groups.
- Targeted group work to young people who have been identified as needing extra input in these areas.
- Support safety events such as Crucial Crew and PACT days.

Young People's Services

Befriending

- Befriending to young people aged 11 years plus across Norfolk.
- Those that are at medium to high risk of sexual exploitation.
- Those young people that are being sexually exploited.
- Befriending has no time limit but looks at a 6 month period.
- Open to male and females.
- Activities done to engage where young person is at.
- Service is voluntary.

Young People's Services

Youth Work Programme

- Specialist programme to work with young people at risk of sexual exploitation.
- Youth groups will run for young people.
- Informal setting with social activities and specialist workshops.
- Young people led service.
- Start in September 2013

Young People's Services

Street Outreach

- Targeted outreach to known hotspots such as parks, bus stations, hostels, bars etc.
- Help to keep young people safe particularly from CSE.
- Will focus on Norwich area.
- If there are concerns from other areas we will look at this.
- Young people to informed about the youth group and befriending if appropriate.

Young People's Services

Return to Home Interviews

- Worker to be based in the MASH.
- Will conduct return to home interviews with young people.
- Assess CSE risk issue.
- Highlight the risks of CSE to young people to help keep them safe.
- Will offer befriending to young people.
- Befriending is voluntarily.

Young People's Services

Telephone Helpline and Internet Live Chat

- Freephone telephone helpline for young people and women.
- Internet live chat facility.
- Operating daytime office hours and currently evenings for 2 hours.
- Will be targeted to those that are entering sexually risky behaviour online to let them know about our support service.
- Might be concerns around sexting, grooming, coercion, exploitation and sex work.
- All safeguarding concerns to be passed on to the MASH.
